From the pastor...

Next Saturday is the Feast of St. Francis de Sales. He is the patron saint of the Diocese of Columbus, probably because he was the patron of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, from which the Diocese of Columbus was partitioned.

Because of the skill with which he wrote pamphlets to try to bring back Swiss Calvinists back to the Catholic Church, and the success of that effort, he is also the patron saint of journalists.

Because he was the first to offer the sacraments of Communion and Reconciliation to a deaf person (his valet), he is the patron saint of the deaf. Before Francis, many did not recognize the intelligence of deaf people because they could not communicate with them.

With St. Jane Frances de Chantal, he founded the Visitation Order of contemplative nuns, who were actually intended by the founders to be an order that practiced an internal contemplative spirit while visiting the poor and sick. Today, nuns of the first federation are purely contemplative, living in monasteries and sisters of the second federation come closer to the intentions of the founders, adding apostolic ministries to their monastic life.
