### ***From the pastor...***

Next Sunday will begin our 2015 Bishop's Annual Appeal Campaign. Our goal this year is \$43,254.00. The goal is based on our Sunday collection compared to that of other parishes and on our registered membership compared to that of other parishes. Of course, we will have envelopes in the pews, as usual, for you to make your pledge with or without a downpayment in the envelope.

Since approaching 50 of you are using eGiving for your parish contributions through FaithDirect, I wanted to let you know that you can do the same thing with your BAA contributions. You can go to the diocesan website <http://www.coldsdioc.org> and sign up for eGiving for the BAA with a FaithDirect account. But I also discovered that I could sign in to my parish FaithDirect account, click on "Add a New Church or Organization," enter "Diocese of Columbus" in the search field and add the BAA to my parish FaithDirect account. One user name, one password for both Parish and BAA, and all my contribution information in one place. I can administer or adjust my BAA contributions just as I can my parish contribution.
