From the pastor...

In the month of May, the Knights of Columbus will be leading the Rosary before each of the Sunday Masses.

File this under "things you learn on the way to somewhere else." We all know that St. Pope John Paul II introduced us all to the luminous mysteries of the Rosary in his 2002 Apostolic Letter *Rosarium Virginis Mariae* [On the Rosary of the Virgin Mary]:

The Baptism in the Jordan
The Wedding at Cana
The Proclamation of the Kingdom
The Transfiguration
The Institution of the Eucharist

Father George Preca, founder of the Society of Christian Doctrine, was beatified by St. Pope John Paul II in 2001 and canonized by Pope Benedict XVI in 2007. As influenced by St. Louis Grignon de Montfort as was St. Pope John Paul II, in 1957 for his fiftieth birthday, St. George Preca proposed five luminous mysteries of the Rosary:

When Our Lord Jesus Christ, after His baptism in the Jordan, was led into the desert.

When Our Lord Jesus Christ showed, by word and miracles, that He is true God.

When Our Lord Jesus Christ taught the Beatitudes on the mountain.

When Our Lord Jesus Christ was transfigured on the mountain.

When Our Lord Jesus Christ had His last Meal with the Apostles.
