From the pastor...

Next Sunday is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We usually call it "Corpus Christi" for short, although that is not exactly correct. Until 1969, there were separate feasts for the Body of Christ and the Blood of Christ. Now we have combined them on the day of the original Feast of the Most Holy Body of Christ, which is the Thursday after Trinity Sunday. In countries where it is a holy day of obligation, that is when the feast is celebrated. However, in the United States, we celebrate the solemnity on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday.

The feast may have come about because it seemed difficult to celebrate the institution of the Eucharist on Holy Thursday in the middle of Holy Week with enough joyfulness and outdoor public processions. So the feast of Corpus Christi was established.

Our west deanery Corpus Christi celebration will be at Sts. Simon and Jude Parish in West Jefferson. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, prayers for the sick, vocations and peace will take place from 12:00-4:00 p.m. Evening Prayer, Procession and Benediction will follow at 4:00. There will be a reception afterwards.

St. Christopher will be hosting a Diocesan Protecting God's Children program on **June 24th**, in the **Trinity Cafeteria**, from **6:00-9:00 p.m.** Go to www.virtus.org and begin the registration process. After registering, view the list of sessions. Select Columbus OH, and register for the St. Christopher session. This program is required for all those who volunteer or work with children within the Catholic Diocese.
