Festival News – We are down to one more week and the Festival begins. Over 27 years, Saint Mary Magdalene has been having a summer Festival. We are in the process of putting on our 2015 annual event. It will run from Friday, June 12, 6:00 p.m.-12:00 a.m. and Saturday, June 13, 5:00 p.m.-12:00 a.m. This is our biggest fund raiser of the year. Last year, we made \$14,000.00 from the Festival. The bulletin indicates we are running a deficit of over \$67,000.00. We hope to exceed last year’s profits. In a good year, we make around \$20,000.00. The proceeds go into the general fund to help reduce debt. Parishioners working together make this a meaningful event. It takes a lot of volunteers to make the Festival successful. We need help with:

- Volunteers for our late shifts of grocery booth, cake booth, snow cones and silent auction.
- We need prior Bingo Workers to sell instants.
- We need more grocery baskets made. Pick up a card for basket suggestions.
- Pick up a cake mix or donate a cake for the cake wheel.
- Help with setup and tear down.

If at all possible, consider working two shifts. We set a record last year for the amount of volunteers, 163. The more that sign up the easier it is to put on the festival. Come support our Festival and be a part of the festivities. We look forward to seeing you. For the people that have signed up, thank you.
