From the Pastor...

The Marian Foundation is a long-time supporter of St. Mary Magdalene Parish and the support we have received this year is truly remarkable. In addition to separate support for the Athletic Association and St. Vincent de Paul Society, the Foundation this year contributed \$6,000.00 to our Tuition Assistance Program and \$3,000.00 to special instruction programs in our school. We also received the third \$3,000.00 installment on an \$18,000.00 pledge to pay for the new ramp access to the modular classroom.

Last December, the Marian Foundation made a \$5,000.00 contribution to fund data base building to prepare for a 60th Anniversary Celebration and Fund Raiser for our school and parish.
