From the pastor...

Leanne Brown wrote a cookbook as part of her master's degree in food studies work. She posted a free PDF copy of the book online and got 100,000 downloads in a matter of a couple of weeks. She then self-published a print edition that sold out in a few months. Also available as a PDF, more than a half-million copies were downloaded within six months. The second edition added 30 new recipes and is a *New York Times* Bestseller.

The book is titled *Good and Cheap, Eat Well on \$4.00 a Day*. It is filled with about 100 recipes for breakfast, lunch, and dinner that make up balanced, healthy meals, costing less than \$4.00/day per person for all three meals. The volume is richly illustrated. The book is designed to provide a healthy, varied, and delicious diet for families on a limited food budget, even SNAP! Almost all of the recipes can be vegetarian, if that's your program.

Here's our plan: If you make a \$10.00 donation, you will receive a copy of *Good and Cheap* and you will enable us to give a copy of the book to clients served by our food pantry and to others for whom the price would be a hardship.

Here's an additional challenge. I'd like to invite you to cook from the recipes in the book for at least three meals a week during Lent, including one each of breakfast, lunch and dinner. Then deposit the savings from your food budget in your Lenten rice bowl. That way you can make a contribution to others who are on an even more limited food budget. It's a wonderful Lenten project for the family.
