In addition to funding our efforts to establish an SMM Alumni Association and last year making a leadership contribution of \$10,000.00 to the St. Mary Magdalene Endowment in the Catholic Foundation, the Marian Foundation continues to assist the parish this year with a number of further grants.

This includes \$6,000.00 for our tuition assistance program, \$3,000.00 to assist with specials teachers in the school, and the fourth \$3,000.00 installment to pay for the replacement of the ramp to Raymond Hall.

The Marian Foundation also provided a grant of \$3,000.00 for the SMM Athletic Program which benefits the parish and our whole neighborhood.

The St. Vincent de Paul society received a \$5,000.00 grant for its regular work assisting the poor in our area as well as a \$2,500.00 grant for its Holiday Projects.

As pastor, I am extremely grateful to the Marian foundation for their continued support of our ministries in the Hilltop area. I hope you will join me in thanking them for their good and generous work among us and alongside us.
