Next Sunday is the Solemn Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. Of course, it is also the middle of Memorial Day weekend. But remember, the celebration of Corpus Christi is hundreds of years older than Memorial Day!

The annual West Deanery "Corpus Christi" celebration will take place here at St. Mary Magdalene. We have tried to simplify the activities a bit to allow more people to celebrate in the middle of their holiday weekend. The entire function will take place inside the air-conditioned church.

The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed after the 11:00 a.m. Mass. Exposition will occur in the Blessed Sacrament chapel. During the approximate one hour of Exposition, the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Anointing will be available. The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed at 2:00 p.m. and the closing worship service will begin. There will be short readings, short talks, hymns and choir anthems. The Blessed Sacrament will be solemnly exposed on the main altar, a Eucharistic meditation read, and Benediction with the Blessed Sacrament given. The service will be concluded by 3:00 p.m. and all are invited to the church hall for a wine and cheese and lemonade and cookie reception.

Please allow your family time to participate, especially those involved in liturgical ministries. I hope to see you Sunday.
