### ***From the pastor...***

The parish financial report for the fiscal year July 2015 through June 2016 is in the bulletin this week. It is a good report. Both the school and parish are on a solid footing for the first time in many years. We will be careful, frugal, and monitor income and expenditures carefully and so keep the parish doing well this year, and in years to come.

As you go through this report, please keep in mind that what you see are only operating income and expenditures. Things like the new boiler in St. Mary Magdalene Hall and the new roof on the modular building do not show up as expenditures. Instead, they show up on the balance sheet as leasehold improvements, that is, the purchase of new assets. It's as though we exchanged cash balances for physical assets without making any expenditures.

Don't let the complications get in the way. Just compare receipts and expenditures from two years ago with receipts and expenditures from this past year, line by line, and you will get a good idea of our financial situation.
