**From the pastor...**

Many years ago, the Diocese of Columbus was involved in the formation of the Community Shelter Board as the entity that would coordinate our community's response to homelessness. The Community Shelter Board (CSB) makes an impact in three ways; bringing partners together to work as an efficient system, employing a performance based funding model and implementing best practices based programs that effectively house people in crisis. CSB programs serve over 12,000 people a year.

The Community Shelter Board is continuing its annual community-wide campaign entitled "From Homeless to Home" during the Lenten season. You can participate by visiting their website at [www.fromhomelesstohome.org](http://www.fromhomelesstohome.org) or you can put your contribution in an envelope marked "From Homeless to Home" and drop it in the Sunday collection. We will forward it to the diocese who will pass it on to the shelter board.
