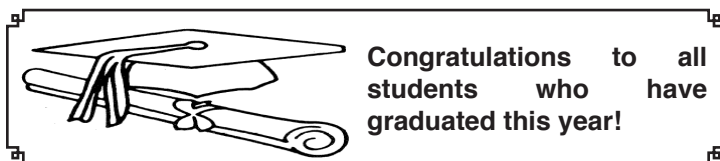
From the pastor...

It has been a decade since I wrote about Pentecost in this space, mostly because the timing of the feast puts it in the middle of the season where my column was filled with Festival announcements!

Pentecost was originally (and still is) a Jewish feast day, celebrated 50 days after Passover ("pentecost" means "fiftieth"). It came to be associated with the giving of the Law on Sinai. It was the Law that distinguished the people of God from the nations, and the Law that made life in community possible, regulating human relations according to God's will in great detail.

Christian Pentecost is celebrated 50 days after Easter. It celebrates the giving of the Holy Spirit to the Church, the Law written in our hearts, the Christian moral intuition that makes it possible for us to look at a situation and see right from wrong and the grace to choose to do the right. It is the Holy Spirit dwelling in us that distinguishes us from the nations and that makes life in community possible, inspiring and informing human relations according to God's will. Pentecost is the suitable culmination of the entire Easter Season.

Pentecost is such an important Church feast that, in several European countries, the Monday (or even Tuesday) following are holy days of obligation. In France, an officially secular nation, the Monday after Pentecost is a civil holiday. Sometimes, the holiday is called Whitsunday, referring to the white baptismal gowns worn to Church on this day by the neophytes who were baptized at the Easter Vigil. The Church provides an extended version of the Pentecost vigil Mass that provides four Scripture readings before the epistle, which reminds us of the Easter Vigil. This feast solemnly concludes the Easter season.

The West Deanery Corpus Christi Celebration will be hosted by St. Patrick Church, 61 South Union Street, London, on Sunday, June 18, 2017. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for Adoration at the conclusion of the 10:30 a.m. Mass. Opportunity for private prayer will continue until 4:00 p.m., when Evening Prayer will be sung; followed by an outdoor Procession of the Blessed Sacrament; concluding with Benediction. Fr. Leo Connolly, Dean of the West Deanery, will be presiding. Homilist will be newly ordained Fr. Daniel Olvera of Holy Family. A light reception will follow in the adjacent St. Patrick Parish Center. The church and center are handicap accessible.

This is the 20th Anniversary of the joint Corpus Christi gathering of the parishes of the West Deanery. Way back in 1997, the pastors of the West Deanery began this special event with an emphasis on prayers for vocations and an increase in reverence for our Eucharistic Lord. Since then, from the West Deanery, eight priests and five permanent deacons have been ordained. Two women and two men have made a solemn profession in the religious life. Currently, there are two seminarians and four aspirants to the permanent diaconate. Our parishes have regularly scheduled times of Eucharistic Adoration. Our prayers have been fruitful!

Let us join together in confident prayer before the Lord Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament for all of our needs, especially on this Father’s Day.
