### ***From the pastor...***

Fr. Dennis Chriszt, C.P.P.S., will be with us next weekend to ask for your support for the work of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood. Each year, we are given the opportunity to hear about the missionary work of the Church and to support that work through our financial gifts and our prayers. The Missionaries of the Precious Blood are based in Dayton, Ohio, but they also serve the Church in Guatemala, Chile, Peru and Colombia. Next weekend, we will take up a special collection at all the Masses and if you want to prepare a check to bring along, the check should be written out to St. Mary Magdalene Church and marked for the missions. Please welcome Fr. Dennis with warm hospitality and respond to his message with generosity.

The Missionaries of the Precious Blood believe that the redeeming power of the Blood of Christ can save the world. Because Christ shed His Blood for all, the Missionaries preach of Christ's all-inclusive love, especially for those whom society may view as too poor or lowly to be of any value. Their ministry, then, often calls them to the fringes of society, such as in their missions in Chile, Colombia, Peru and Guatemala, where they serve parishes in sprawling urban centers, in villages high in the mountains and among country people who may otherwise seldom see a priest. In those countries, they have worked with the people to establish schools, clinics and many parish ministries. They are ministers of the Word who have seen the Word work great miracles among the lives of the people to whom they minister – and in themselves.
