### ***From the pastor...***

I wanted to let you all know my circumstances. I have prostate cancer, which is a slow growing type. The prognosis is very favorable. After a month or so of preparations, I will commence a course of radiation therapy, every day, five days a week for at least nine weeks. One of the side effects will be fatigue. Of course, the time for treatments will put a big hole in my availability. Scheduling some things in the parish may be difficult. I'm trying to arrange the treatments in the afternoon so that they won't interfere with Mass schedules, including funerals. I have started moving some basic things into my apartment, which is quite close to the treatment facility, so that I can spend a night or two there each week, to get some rest.

All this being said, I would like to ask you all to keep me in your prayers, both for healing and for patience in dealing with the inconvenient course of treatment.
